Mr. Price called the meeting to order at 12:27 p.m. and established the presence of a quorum.

Agenda Item No. 3 - Approval of minutes of May 16, 2017

Mr. Bailey made a motion to approve the minutes of May 16, 2017 as presented; Ms. Collins seconded the motion, which passed by acclamation.

Agenda Item No. 4 - Discussion regarding July 22, 2017 Ethnic Fair

Mr. Price stated all of the entry forms are at the library, CCC and the main drop off is the Chamber of Commerce. The deadline is July 19th. He sent an extensive mailout to all of the participants for the last 2-3 years.

Mr. Price asked the committee members to include the posters for the Ethnic Fair and Food Drive on their personal facebook accounts.

Mr. Price stated the businesses on Main Street have allowed him to put the signs up. He asked the committee to take posters to give to various businesses to post.

Mr. Price stated he will be in contact with someone from the base regarding volunteers.

Mr. Price stated he would like to speak with some of the assisted living centers to have them bring seniors to the event. He wants to set up a canopy or two near the stage for them.

Mr. Price spoke with Michael Watson regarding a karate demo during the children's hour. He also asked Ms. Byrd if she could have her group together to perform a dance. Ms. Byrd stated they have not practiced in a while and she would see what she could do.

Ms. Collins asked if she could get a map of the vendor layout to keep at the front desk so that she doesn't have to keep calling Mr. Price to ask questions. Mr. Price stated he would see what he could do.
