PROGRAM GUIDELINES

What is the City of Clovis Summer Youth Program?

The City of Clovis Summer Youth Program is designed to provide local youth from ages 5-11 with opportunities to engage with the outdoors and learn about the environment. The program is held for eight weeks throughout the months of June and July. This is the second year of the City of Clovis Summer Youth Program and is funded by the New Mexico Outdoor Equity Fund and the City of Clovis.

The 2023 Summer Youth Program will be held from June 5 - July 28, 2023, at Roy Walker Recreation Center, located at 316 W 2nd Street in Clovis. The hours of the program will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. with a 30 minute drop off/pick up period before and after the program each day. Breakfast, lunch and snacks will be provided each day, and field trips will also be organized throughout the summer.

The program is organized by the City of Clovis and the Parks & Recreation Department to provide local youth with affordable summer programming centered around environmental education. A seasonal Program Coordinator will be responsible for the overall planning and implementation of the program, with the help of ten program assistants and other staff from the City of Clovis.

Who is <u>eligible</u> for the Summer Youth Program?

Participants must live in Clovis and must be between the ages of 5 and 11 by the start of the program in June. At least 40% of recruited participants will come from low-income households, which will be verified with the application. Multiple students from one household may apply for the program as long as they meet the age requirements.

The Summer Youth Program is available to all children, including participants with disabilities. Programming and activities will be organized in a way that can accommodate participants with special needs, and should a participant require an aid or additional support to undergo the program, no additional fees will be collected for this accommodation.

What is the cost of the Summer Youth Program, and how will payments be due?

Tuition for the program is a total of \$250.00, which is comprised of \$30.00 per week per child with a one-time \$10.00 registration fee per child. During the first day of the program on Monday, June 5, 2023, a total of \$40.00 (\$30.00 weekly fee plus \$10.00 registration fee) will be due. Thereafter, \$30.00 will be due every Friday to pay for the week ahead.

Parents will receive further insight into how payments will be collected once their child is selected for the program.

How can you <u>apply</u> for the Summer Youth Program?
