Discussion and recommendation regarding residential street paving, Clint

Bunch

Mr. Bunch advised he had updated costs for the roadway prioritization recommendations. The total cost would be \$1,048,545.35.

District 1

Nancy Lopez Drive from Fairway Terrace to Fairway Terrace
Corlington Lane from Llano Estacado to Fairway Terrace

District 2

4th Street from Prince Street to Axtell Street
6th Street from Prince Street to Axtell Street

District 3

11th Street from Thornton Street to Hull Street
12th Street from Thornton Street to Hull Street

District 4

North Village from Llano Estacado south to end
Wallace Street from Llano Estacado to Tierra Blanca

Commissioner Porter asked why the unit price for District 1 was \$27 but everything else was \$25.50. Mr. Bunch advised some of the areas that are cul-de-sacs are harder to get to so the price is a little more. Commissioner Jones made a motion to recommend the list of recommendations; Mr. Petty seconded the motion, which passed by acclamation.

Mayor Pro Tem Bryant asked when the work would start. Mr. Bunch advised this would begin in late August/early September.

Update on current projects

Sugar Beet Road

This has been bid and awarded by the City Commission. It will go from US 60/70/84 North of Cooks. K Barnett received the award at \$400,000 including GRT. This has to be completed by December

MLK

This is out to bid and the prebid meeting was held. Bids are due in August.

Main Street sidewalks from grand to 2nd

NMDOT has approved the plans and FHWA have given permission to bid. Projects submitted to NMDOT for Transportation Project Funds will be heard at the special meeting in August. They submitted for the Purdue drainage improvements, design on Llano between Norris and Humphrey and rebuilding Commerce from Prince to Main.

7th Street

Some storm drain work will need to be completed and the line stabilization is being worked on. Once they finish the storm drain they will continue the curb and gutter and sidewalk work.

CHS

The new LED lighting system at the stadium is complete.

The Rock

The lower part has been painted, they added to the mural and have redone the floors. The bleachers on the second level were replaced with new ADA bleachers.

Band practice field

They are building a fence around the field and they are currently installing lighting.

They are getting new roofs and HVAC.

Marshall

This is now the 6th Grade Academy. They are installing a new LED sign on Commerce and working on the landscaping. Convocation is August 4th so they plan to be ready for that.

Gattis

They have installed lighting at the football field. The plan is to hold football games on both Gattis and Yucca fields.

Student support

This is the new I Academy. They have moved SSC staff to other parts of the district. It will be a year out before they can get anyone in the building.
